Theory classes	Theoretical teaching and exercises are in a very closely related, and through the theoretical part of teaching students are introduced to the area that will then be covered in practical classes: morphology: verb, noun, determiner, pronoun, adjective; syntax: phrases, sentences, word order; content in the field of German culture.
