Develops a program and activities that stimulate and support the development of creativity. Applies innovative models and procedures in the Methodology of Art Education. They know contemporary concepts of preschool education, as well as the system of organization of art education in preschool institutions, legal regulations, rights and duties of preschool teachers and other employees. Students understand the complexity of the role of the educator in the kindergarten and know how to recognize and explain specific roles. Understands the importance of continuous professional development and lifelong learning in the Methodology of Art Education and can plan personal and professional development in the field of art education.</p>
