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## LANGUAGE POLICY

Preschool Teacher Training College *Mihailo Palov* Vrsac offers language support to Erasmus+ incoming and outgoing students and staff members, in order to provide outgoing students and staff with all the possible opportunities to get engaged in mobilities and for incoming students to become genuine members of the intercultural academic community of our institution.

Preschool Teacher Training College *Mihailo Palov* Vrsac organises:

- **Intensive Serbian and Romanian Language Courses** – beginner level (6 hours/week for 10 weeks) during the 1<sup>st</sup> semester (October – December) and the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (February – May) – for a group of minimum 10 participants, free of charge for incoming Erasmus students registered at Preschool Teacher Training College *Mihailo Palov*.
- **Intensive English Language Courses** – B1 level (4 months – a group requires a minimum number of 10 participants, free of charge for students and staff members from the Preschool Teacher Training College *Mihailo Palov*.

If you want to attend an Intensive Serbian and Romanian Language Course you are invited to contact Institutional Department for International Relations at [eugencinci@gmail.com](mailto:eugencinci@gmail.com)

The course offers the opportunity for students to quickly integrate into the local setting and get along with Serbian (Romanian, Romani) students. At the end of the course you are delivered a language certificate mentioning the total number of hours, the level of the course as well as the number of credits awarded (5 ECTS).

As for learning opportunities, the possibilities are endless. Apart from the fact that all the courses are taught in the Serbian language, the incoming students have the opportunity to attend classes for certain courses in Romanian, Romani, Russian or English language (detailed information in the Course catalogue, i.e. curriculum, available at: <https://www.uskolavrsac.edu.rs/curriculum/>).
